Tri-Color Pottery, used as funerary objects during the Tang Dynasty, was first discovered in the late 18th Century when tombs were pulled apart during construction of a railroad between Kai-feng to Lo-yang. Over the next decades, the objects attracted the attention of collectors and museums, prompting local people to dig them up, resulting in the damage of many beautiful pieces. Digging was halted until 1949, when Chinese archeologists resumed digging, recovering more of the pottery.
